Welcome to another season of Little League Baseball and Softball!

Our program begins as early as age 4 (their age as of Aug 31, 2026-Baseball & Jan 1, 2026-Softball).

BASEBALL CLASSIFICATION

*League age as of August 31, 2026

T-ball (age 4-5) and **Coach Pitch** (5-7): Co-ed teams season starts in May; home games played at Nutting Park or South School

Machine Pitch (6-8) and **Minors** (8-11) Season starts in late April; home games are played at Nutting Park or South School

Majors: (9-10), (11-12), **Juniors** (13-14), **Seniors** (15-16) Opening day is in mid April (TBD) To be on a majors team, you must complete an evaluation and be drafted to a team. Home games for Majors 9-10 & 11-12 play at Thomson Park, Juniors (13-14) & Seniors (15-16) play on Dodger Field at Thomson Park

SOFTBALL CLASSIFICATION

*League age as of January 1, 2026

Minors: (age 6-9) Machine Pitch

9/10 Majors: Player Pitch, players 8 years old may try out

11/12 Majors: Player Pitch, players 10 years old may try out

Seniors: (ages 13-16) These leagues are organized by the district and may be combined. There is a link on our website to register for Juniors and Seniors.

BASEBALL/SOFTBALL PLAYER EVALUATIONS

ALL Laurel players League Age 9+ wishing to be considered for a Majors teams MUST attend 1 player evaluation!

Coaches will evaluate whether players will be placed on Major or Minor League teams. League age 8 players are welcome to attend if they wish to attempt to be placed on a Majors team. Evaluations are held at:

2026 REGISTRATION FEES

Our fees help pay the costs of the Little League program: equipment, fields and maintenance, and administrative costs for insurance, rentals and national dues.

Laurel-based team registration fees for 2025:

- T-ball/Coach Pitch \$130.00 Early Bird=\$90
- Machine Pitch \$180.00 Early Bird=\$140
- SB/Minors & Up \$190.00 Early Bird=\$150

DISCOUNTS, REBATES, & SCHOLARSHIPS

While our rates are more reasonable than many in our area, there are ways to save on registration costs. Manager (head coach) approved by LLL can receive a rebate of up to 50% of registration fee for the level of play coached (to be dispersed at the end of the season). Family discount after the first registration is \$20 off for each additional registered player.

LAUREL LITTLE LEAGUE BOARD MEETINGS

Meetings take place on the First Sunday of every month at 6:00pm at Fowl Play in Laurel. Additional meetings are held as needed. The Board must approve all expenditures, coaches, volunteers, policies, and schedules. Anyone is welcome to attend and participate at these meetings.

HOW IS THE MONEY SPENT?

Annual program costs are about \$78,000 a year. Registration fees alone do not cover our costs, and that is why team sponsorships are so valuable to offset the amount a family has to pay. The breakdown of expenses includes:

- -25% uniforms
- -25% equipment (baseball, softball and field)
- -10% Little League International fees
- -30% field maintenance (baseball maintains 5 fields and assists with the Legion field; softball maintains 4 fields)
- -10% misc. (electric, garbage, tryouts, toilets, administrative supplies).
